REDESIGN A BOOK COVER

BRIEF

We would like you to design a fresh and exciting cover look for this fabulous and fun book. Primarily aimed at children aged 9 to 11, your design should ensure that this book opens the door to reading the whole series and cements its place as a must-read for mystery fans, as well as welcoming new readers to the adventures that are full of friendship and intrigue.

Murder Most Unladylike is the first book in a series of 10. As part of your cover design, you are required to design a series logo. The logo can be any shape you wish, but it must include the series name – A Murder Most Unladylike Mystery. The logo can be typographic only or you may wish to include simple images or graphic icons. Your logo design will need to work effectively at different sizes and should appear on the front cover and the spine of your design. You should also consider that the logo needs to work in isolation as well as complementing your cover design.

Your cover design needs to include all the cover copy supplied and be designed to the specified design template (B format, 198mm high x 129mm wide, spine width 21.5mm), incorporating the Puffin branding and all additional elements such as the barcode.
